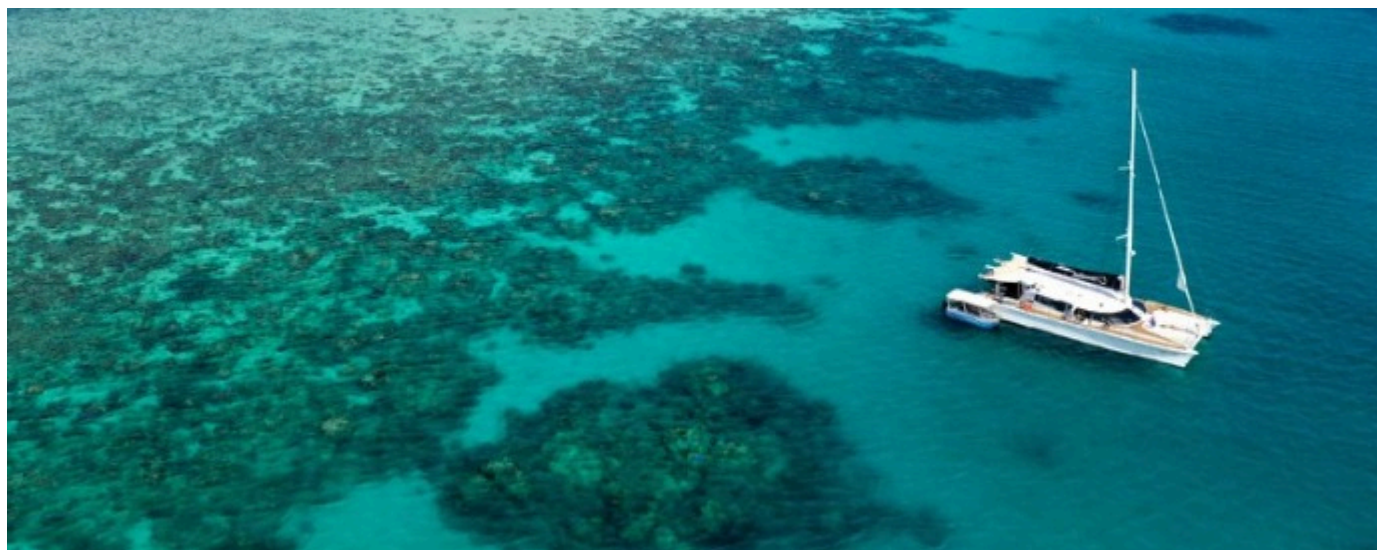

Status Reports
